





Contemporary



The mirror and glass surfaces convey a sense of openness and space despite the division of the room into a dry and a wet zone. The option of dividing the space in two makes it easier for more than one person to use the room at the same time.




Rain panels for two people

Vertical Shower

At the heart of the Vertical Shower concept is its use of several water outlets, which can be controlled either collectively or individually. With the additional rain panels, water cascades down from across large surfaces through the power of gravity alone. Preconfigured scenarios incorporating light, fragrance and sound.

Scenario control

Connectivity simplifies processes and increases convenience.


All products are fully networked, enabling settings to be comprehensively configured to suit people's requirements either ahead of time or spontaneously via an app. A steam bath helps to prevent illness and to maintain and promote health.

Washstand

A double washbasin provides storage and sufficient space for two people. Complementing the fixed outlets, an extendible sprinkler head can be used to wash hair, for example, while an affusion pipe can be used to apply water to individual parts of the body.


Shower toilet

The fully integrated shower toilet ensures well-being and comfort. Washing with pure water and individual washing/temperature settings meet hygiene and cleanliness requirements.




Horizontal Shower

Shower lying down – the Horizontal Shower recuperative function makes the bathroom an even more ideal location for relaxation. Spas across the world offer people a place to recharge their batteries, where water applications are often combined with massage for various types of treatment. This is where the concept has its origins.



Functional outlets

An affusion pipe integrated into the bench enables different treatments. Temperature-alternating showers for specific parts of the body have proven their worth in **promoting circulation and stimulating metabolism.**





Shower space for two

Despite the limited space of just over 6 m², the room offers a range of usage options – also for two people. This applies in particular to the generous and luxurious shower area, which is separated from the rest of the space by a glass barrier. A deep floor option can be chosen to enable a few centimetres of water to build up in this wet zone for more treatment flexibility.

The idea behind SSPS®

A feeling of spaciousness in a minimum of space – in his architecture concept “Small Size Premium Spa”, SSPS® for short, Michael Sieger has turned his attention to the modern premium bathroom and the way it reflects societal trends. In an area of approx. 6m², SSPS® offers a wide variety of usage options that meet the highest standards in terms of comfort, functionality and enhanced quality of life. The concept can be individually reinterpreted in a variety of designs, styles, features, materials, surfaces and colours.

The “Small Size Premium Spa” concept is based on a carefully designed zone architecture and a functional arrangement of elements. The spacious wet zone, measuring approx. 3.5m², is only separated from the dry zone by a glass screen. The two zones create a spacious and harmonious ambience.



There is a wide variety of usage options. For example, SSPS® features both a Vertical and a Horizontal Shower. The integrated rain panel in the ceiling brings the world of nature indoors. And since the innovative shower applications make it just as comfortable to shower lying down as to take a bath, there's

no need for a bathtub. If a bathtub is expressly required, it can be precisely integrated (in combination with a footbath, for example) and covered when necessary so that it can be used as a seat during other regenerative treatments. Preconfigured scenarios blend light, fragrance and sound to create a soothing experience for all the senses. Just like a steam bath, these also help prevent illness and maintain and promote health.

In the dry zone, a double washbasin provides storage and sufficient space for two people. Extendable sprinkler heads and affusion pipes can be used to apply water to individual parts of the body, complementing the fixed outlets. The room is fully networked, which is highly convenient: settings for the room can be comprehensively configured to suit users' requirements either ahead of time or spontaneously via an app from wherever they happen to be.

Ein großzügiges Raumerlebnis auf minimaler Fläche – in seinem Architekturkonzept „Small Size Premium Spa“, kurz SSPS®, widmet sich Michael Sieger dem modernen Premiumbad im Spiegel gesellschaftlicher Trends. Auf rund 6m² erfüllt SSPS® mit zahlreichen Nutzungsmöglichkeiten höchste Ansprüche an Komfort, Funktionalität und gesteigerter Lebensqualität. Dabei lässt sich das Konzept für verschiedene Design- und Stilwelten interpretieren und in der Ausstattung, der Material-, Oberflächen- und Farbwahl individuell variieren.

Eine durchdachte Zonen-Architektur und funktionsorientierte Anordnung der Elemente sind die Basis des Small Size Premium Spa. Die großzügige Nass-Zone, die ca. 3,5m² Fläche umfasst, ist nur durch eine Glaswand von der Trocken-Zone getrennt. Beide Bereiche verschmelzen zu einem offenen, harmonischen Raumgefüge.

Die Nutzungsoptionen sind vielfältig. So bietet SSPS® eine vertikale und eine horizontale Dusche. Das in die Decke integrierte Regenpaneel holt Phänomene der Natur direkt ins Haus. Da neue Duschanwendungen im Liegen einen ähnlichen Komfort wie das Baden bieten, kann auf eine Badewanne verzichtet werden. Ist diese explizit gewünscht, lässt sie sich – zum Beispiel gemeinsam mit einem Fußbad – passgenau integrieren, bei Bedarf abdecken und so schließlich als Sitzbank für weitere regenerative Anwendungen nutzen. Vorprogrammierte Szenarien binden Licht, Duft und Sound ein, um wohlende Sinneserlebnisse zu schaffen. Wie das Dampfbad dienen sie der Prävention, erhalten und fördern die Gesundheit.

In der Trocken-Zone gewährt ein Doppelwaschtisch Stauraum und ausreichend Platz für zwei Personen. Herausziehbare Brausen oder Gießrohre für Teilkörperanwendungen können hier stationäre Armaturen ergänzen. Die vollkommene Vernetzung erhöht den Komfort. So lassen sich komplette Szenarien nicht nur zeitlich vordefinieren, sondern auch spontan per App von überall den aktuellen Bedürfnissen anpassen.

The mission statement of sieger design is to develop brand concepts and products with a unique selling point that are distinctive and success-oriented. The design agency has been driving significant trends in the sanitary industry since the early 1980s and has been the innovative force behind many types of product: the first designer bathroom fittings, holistic bathroom collections, expansive rain effect systems and scenario-controlled showers.

At Harkotten Castle, the design process is managed by an interdisciplinary team of around 45 employees. Working on behalf of partners in the industry such as Dornbracht, Alape and Duravit as well as a host of other international brands, the company develops holistic strategies and designs that are based on scientifically sound analysis and visionary thinking. Michael Sieger and his team work with the utmost sensitivity, an eye for timeless, often archetypal forms and a keen understanding of functionality, innovation and sustainability.

Auf Schloss Harkotten bilden rund 45 Mitarbeiter den Designprozess interdisziplinär ab. Für Partner wie Dornbracht, Alape und Duravit, aber auch für viele weitere internationale Marken entstehen ganzheitliche Strategien und Entwürfe, die auf fundierten Analysen und vorausschauendem Denken basieren. Dabei gehen Michael Sieger und sein Team mit höchster Sensibilität, dem Auge für zeitlose, oft archetypische Formen, dem Sinn für Funktionalität, Innovation und Nachhaltigkeit vor.

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
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
